

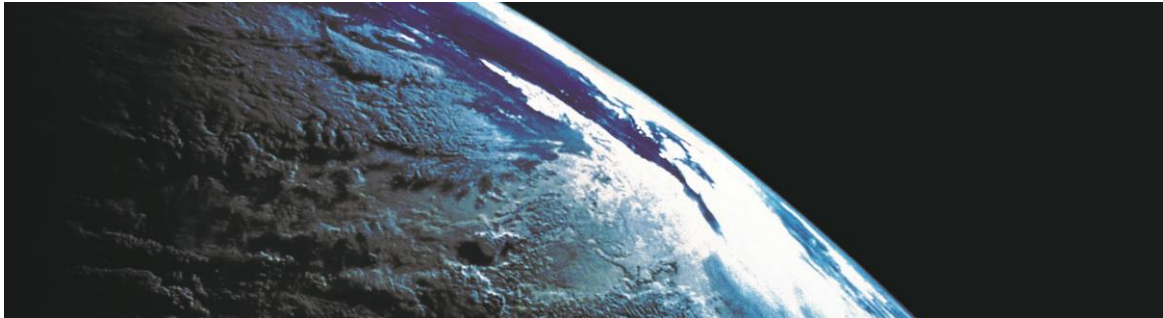

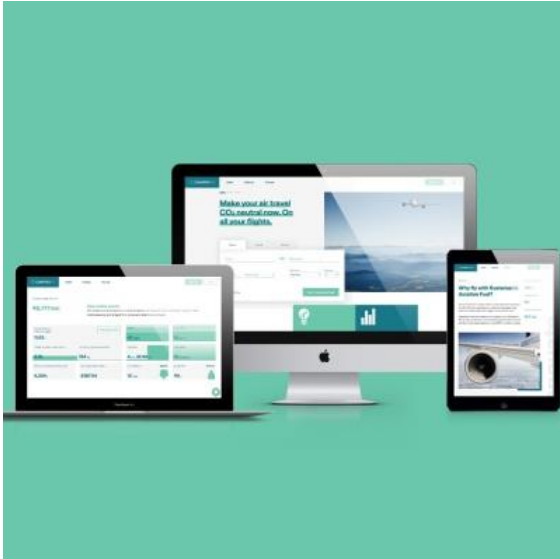


Non stop from Stuttgart to Hungary's capital - LOT Polish Airlines develops hub in Budapest

LOT Polish Airlines a Star Alliance member has been consistently expanding its network of connections from Budapest, that becomes a second hub (Warsaw remaining the main hub): On September 22nd 2019 LOT Polish Airlines is going to launch 3 weekly non-stop flights to Seoul and on 30th of March next year, six new destinations will be proposed: Stuttgart, Sofia, Prague, Belgrade, Bucharest and Brussels, thereby operating 12 routes from Budapest. The launch of new international flights from Hungary marks another stage of market consolidation in Central and Eastern Europe, of which LOT Polish Airlines is currently becoming an undisputed leader.
